

# The Day We Will Remember Forever

On December 30, 1995 Ricky was working as usual in a steel mill's Electric Arc Furnace combustion chamber. Suddenly, a piece of slag fell out and struck him in the head, fracturing his skull and shoving a section of bone to where it pressed dangerously against his brain.

### Ricky's "Lucky" A C C I D E N T

Despite this terrible brush with death and his extended recovery, Ricky later realized that the most dramatic impact of the accident hadn't actually happened, because he survived. But what if he'd died? How might his beloved family have suffered emotionally, financially and spiritually, perhaps for years?

Thinking about his family made Ricky widen his circle to his friends, and then to his colleagues. It shocked him to recognize that his survival wasn't the luckiest thing about the accident: he remembered that in the lift basket next to him that day stood another man who trusted Ricky to ensure his safety. That man walked away unhurt—Ricky at last understood that his friend's safety was in fact the luckiest thing that ever happened to Ricky Rollins.
