Notes

RID stands for "Reporting ID" and corresponds the DOLI Office that an inspector works out of. Safety Compliance Officers and Health Compliance Officers have separate RIDs.

All records in this report will have a UPA number, but not all result in inspections (see "Insp #" column).

The UPA number will be prefaced by either a "C" for complaint, "R" for referral, or "F" for fatality.

The "Primary/Site NAICS" column will have two NAICS for each record. The "Primary" NAICS designates the type of work that was the subject of the UPA. The "Site" NAICS designates the NAICS for the entire facility.

"Employer Reported" column indicates when employers are reporting an employee death, hospitalization, amputation or loss of an eye.
