VOSH Alliance Program

VOSH establishes Alliances through a **written agreement** with an organization.

Alliances support VOSH's strategic goals by conducting **collaborative activities** that emphasize:

- Raising awareness through outreach and communication.
- Sharing information on VOSH's regulatory and enforcement activities.
- · Conducting best practice seminars
- Providing opportunities for VOSH to speak or exhibit at conferences and meetings.
- Creating and sharing compliance assistance materials.
- Developing and delivering training and education programs to employers and workers.

Criteria and Fundamental Requirements for Alliances

Alliance participants work with VOSH to help ensure **safe**, **healthy workplaces** for America's workers.

In assessing Alliances to pursue, VOSH will consider factors such as:

- Alignment of the proposed goals with VOSH's strategic priorities.
- Capability of potential participants to achieve goals with sufficient knowledge and expertise.
- Ability to address emerging workplace safety and health issues.
- Demonstrated commitment of potential participants for working cooperatively with VOSH.
- Ability to conduct outreach to high-hazard industries and at-risk workers.



Alliance participants agree to key requirements as a condition of participation:

- Share VOSH updates, campaigns, and resources with members and stakeholders.
- Dedicate time and resources to support Alliance goals and projects.
- Encourage members to participate in VOSH outreach efforts.
- Provide VOSH with relevant data on Alliance activities and impact.
- Promote meaningful worker participation in Alliance initiatives.
- Follow VOSH guidelines for creating and sharing free, public Alliance materials.

Benefits of an Alliance

- Increase worker access to effective workplace safety and health tools.
- Leverage resources to maximize worker safety and health protections.
- Establish progressive dialogue with the agency and others committed to workplace safety and heath.
